What is DECENT about?

The project DECENT “*Digital strategies of Enhancement of the basic skills among adults as a ChancE to fight agaiNst functional illiTeracy*” aims at increasing the effectiveness of the fight against functional illiteracy among low qualified adults who are at risk of a social exclusion in Romania, Poland, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Spain and Italy.

The project is funded by the European Union through the Erasmus+ Programme, Key action 2 (Cooperation for innovation and the exchange of good practices): Strategic Partnership for Adult Education. Its main **targets** are *low-skilled adults* who are at risk of a social exclusion (long-term unemployed, people at risk of poverty, low-educated people), but also *institutions* that support and care for adults at risk of social exclusion (adult education centres, social care institutions, adult schools, third-age universities, associations that support the fight against functional illiteracy and social exclusion) providing them with a very useful set of tools for their work.

What’s new about the project?

In the last months many results have been achieved!

The fourth transnational meeting in Nicosia, Cyprus:



The 6th and 7th of November the partners of DECENT have met for their fourth transnational meeting in Nicosia, Cyprus.

The meeting was an important occasion for partners to, on one hand, draw lessons from the first year of the project, and on the other to exchange ideas and contributions aimed at the successful implementation of DECENT in its second year.

In particular, the DECENT partners have discussed in

detail the contents of the 6 modules of the “*Decent life without illiteracy*” course, and have started setting the basis for the contents of the Open Educational Resource (OER), which will be developed at a later stage.

After the Nicosia meeting, the partners are ready and enthusiastic to keep up the good work and continue working towards the successful implementation of DECENT.

What’s next?

The DECENT partnership will soon finalize the “Decent Life Without Illiteracy” course contents and translate them in all partners’ languages: Italian, Spanish, Polish, Bulgarian, Greek and Romanian.

Moreover, the partners will now start working towards the realization of an **eTool**, a collaborative e-learning platform and digital resource with possibility to interlink pages and topics, include external resources and comments, to contribute to combating functional illiteracy.

The next partners’ meeting will be held in Palermo, Italy, in April 2019.
